



## FIG Level 3 Course

### APPLICATION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

#### ***Application Process***

1. Gymnastics Australia will request Expressions of Interest (EOI) via GA Latest News, Technical Member Bulletins and the GA Website once the course dates are confirmed.
2. Potential participants should complete the EOI application form and submit to GA.
3. GA will verify the information provided and notify any participant who is not eligible.
4. GA will receive course details and application forms from FIG approximately three months prior to the course including the course costs.
5. GA will send a final application form to all participants once this information has been received and will request payment details.
6. GA will submit applicant names to FIG. Confirmation of acceptance is usually received 2 months prior to the course.
7. GA will inform successful candidates as soon as they hear and will process payment.
8. Successful participants should book flights if required.

#### ***CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION***

1. **Current Technical Member** of Gymnastics Australia
2. **Current Advanced Silver Coach Accreditation or above**
3. Currently coaching one of the following:  
**Australian Junior, Senior or International Gymnasts**  
**Australian Level 10 or Aerobics Level 6-7 or equivalent**  
**IDP 8-10**
4. Minimum of **1 year experience** coaching the above
5. Held Advanced Silver Coach Accreditation or GA Level 3 for a **minimum of two years**
6. Evidence of **knowledge of coaching theory**  
(please tick at least one of the following)
  - FIG Level 3 Academy Program
  - FIG Level 2 Academy Program
  - Completed Level 3 Coach Accreditation
  - Completed Level 2 Coach Accreditation
  - Relevant further education e.g. Sport Science, Human Movement (please name)
  - Other (please explain)
7. Evidence of relevant ***continuing professional development*** (please explain)

***Please note that not all applicants who meet the criteria will be accepted onto the course. FIG determines the number of Australian participants per course.***
