3.0	Acceptance of Previous Minutes	Minutes of the previous meeting held on the 23 July, 2009 – accepted.	
4.0	Business Arising from Previous Minutes	<p>4.1 Green Shirts Pilot Scheme (RG & TRP) – Section 11.1 It was noted that this was ongoing and more information would be discussed at the April & July meetings in 2009.</p> <p>4.2 Car-parking Passes (Loftus Recreation Centre) – Section 8.3 It was noted that TOV had provided GWA with 70 car-parking passes for each competition week-end – at this stage this system seemed to be working well.</p>	
5.0	General Business	<p>5.1 Criteria / Selection Panel for an Overall GWA Official of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Service Award. After discussion the following was decided;</p> <p>There would be four GWA Judging Awards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gymsport Official of the year • GWA Official of the year (to be selected from the one of the above Gymsport winners) • Gymsport - Rookie of the year* • Gymsport – Long Service* • Each Gymsport is entitled to select one of these awards. <p>The criteria for each of these Awards were discussed at length, as was the tie-breaker and selection panel requirements for each of the Awards. RG to compile for inclusion in the GWA Awards Regulations for presentation / ratification of the GWA Board.</p>	<p>RG – to complete Award criteria. RK to present to the GWA Board.</p>

	<p>The Gymsports Judging Co-ordinators (or representatives) noted that they would be recommending the following Gymsports Awards</p> <p>WAG – Long service TRP – Rockie AERO – Long Service RG – Long Service Cheer – to pick an award criteria Acro – to pick an award criteria MAG- to pick an award</p> <p>It was agreed that this process needed to be evaluated at the January meeting as to what areas worked and what did not work.</p> <p>5.2 Minimum Judging Requirements 2009 (AER, TRP, ACRO & CHEER) Minimum judging requirements for 2009:</p> <p>AER and TRP = 1 judge per 10 athletes. It was noted that AER needed to be taken back to SMC to discuss further.</p> <p>ACRO and CHEER to be given a further 12 month period</p> <p>It was noted that if a club is taking on a new gym sport, they are given a 12 month grace period with minimum judging requirements. Within the second 12 months a judge is to be in the system.</p> <p>5.3 Photocopying of Judging Slips It was agreed that this was a GWA office responsibility, however Judging Coordinators are to provide 'original proformas' to the office for copying purposes.</p> <p>5.4 Fining and where the gym sports are up to? RK noted that a number of clubs were on the GWA debtors list as a result a letter had been sent to all clubs stating either payment due or a formal dispute to be lodged – if this did not occur then clubs would be denied entry into the forthcoming Op Spec competition.</p> <p>There still continued to be some problems with some Gymsports these included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Delay in Panels being given to GWA from Judging Co-ordinator. • Actual sign in sheets do not match. • Judging coordinator/jury/head judge: to / check record who actually judge at the event. 	<p>Gymsports – as required.</p> <p>AER & TRP As required.</p> <p>Judging Coordinators to provide judging slip proformas – GWA office to copy.</p> <p>Gymsports to address as required.</p>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Delay in office receiving information in relation to judges payments. <p>After discussion the following was agreed in principle;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clubs will be fined if judge has not signed in. It is the individual Clubs responsibility to make sure they sign in. • Jury or Head Judge to do spot check that the people that has signed in is at the session. • Head judge to sign next to form as confirmation that they have judged and are to be paid. • Separate sign in sheets for competitions in a second Door Box. • GWA Office to cross check forms and then payments to be made from sign in sheets. • If any issues with the above then GWA office to refer to judging coordinator. <p>5.5 Judging Education Courses 2009 Judging coordinator to email/hand in education confirmation forms on the 29th January 2009 for courses Jan – June . It was noted that some Gymsports would require money from board to be able to run courses in early 2009.</p> <p>5.7 Judge Credit System TH (WAG) raised the issue that problems could arise in 2009 with the credit system as discussed at the previous meeting.
